Educational Fund

Goals:

- **1.** Provide financial assistance to local High School students who are pursuing an education associated with the construction industry.
- 2. Demonstrate the Seneca County Home Builders Association's commitment to supporting our community and provide aid to local youths that are pursuing a career in construction and building trades.

General Provisions:

- 1. Funds are to be used to assist with tuition for local graduating High School students entering into an institution of higher learning to pursue a degree related to the construction industry. Additionally, funds will be allocated to aid with the purchase of tools and supplies for students and programs at Sentinel Career Center in Tiffin, Ohio which are associated with the construction industry.
- 2. Applications for funding will be accepted via formal pre-approved application designated by the SCHBA Educational Fund Trustees and/or by written request from staff members of Sentinel Career Center. Applications will be made available through local schools, Sentinel Career Center, and on the SCHBA website at http://www.senecacountyhomebuilders.com.
- **3.** The SCHBA Educational Fund Committee shall consist of five current members in good standing of the Seneca County Home Builders Assoc. as approved by the membership.
- **4.** The SCHBA Educational Fund must retain a minimum balance of \$10,000.00 before any funding will be awarded.
- **5.** Assistance provided in the form of tools and/or supplies shall be in the form of a voucher to a local member of the SCHBA whenever possible.

Criteria:

The SCHBA Educational Fund will provide financial assistance to persons who are well-rounded individuals of good moral character that have demonstrated leadership qualities and a desire to be involved in their local community. Candidates will be judged based on their answers to questions posed on the application form along with an essay submitted based on the criteria required by the application. Further, candidates may be asked to submit to a personal interview if it is deemed necessary by the SCHBA Educational Fund Committee members in order to make a final decision. In the event that no acceptable candidate can be found, no funding shall be awarded.
